
Storm Summary for Hurricane Makani2013

Monday, June 3, 2013 at 11 PM HST

(Output from Hurrevac, based on Central Pacific Hurricane Center Forecast Advisory # 16)

Hurricane Makani2013 is currently a Category 3 major hurricane on the Saffir-Simpson Hurricane Wind Scale, with maximum sustained winds of 125 mph (110 kts), moving west-northwest at 14 mph. The estimated minimum central pressure is 955 mb. Hurricane-force winds extend outward up to 60 miles (95 km) from the storm center. Tropical storm-force winds extend outward up to 215 miles (345 km) from the storm center.

Certain coastal locations are under Hurricane Warning as illustrated in the map below. The geographic extents of these watches and warnings are detailed in the advisory text at the end of this report.



Wind Analysis for Maui, HI

Wind Probabilities

LANAI CITY, the closest reporting location, has within the 5-day forecast period of this advisory, a 68% chance of at hurricane-force (64kt/74mph) winds, a 88% chance of at least strong tropical storm-force (50kt/58mph) winds, and a 97% chance of at least tropical storm-force (34kt/39mph) winds.

Peak Wind*

Winds in Maui, HI are projected to peak at 120kt/138mph around 2:00 PM on Tuesday, June 04, 2013

Wind Arrival and Duration*

Tropical storm-force winds (34kt/39mph) are forecast to begin in Maui, HI on Monday, June 03, 2013 at 11:00 PM. Winds of this magnitude or higher are forecast to continue for 34 hours.

Strong tropical storm-force winds (50kt/58mph) are forecast to begin in Maui, HI on Tuesday, June 04, 2013 at 6:00 AM. Winds of this magnitude or higher are forecast to continue for 18 hours.

Hurricane-force winds (64kt/74mph) are forecast to begin in Maui, HI on Tuesday, June 04, 2013 at 9:00 AM. Winds of this magnitude or higher are forecast to continue for 12 hours.

* These wind estimations are limited to the first 72 hours (3 days) following advisory issuance, and are subject to considerable forecast uncertainty and generalization, especially if the storm is distant.

Maximum sustained winds (the highest surface wind maintained over a 1 minute period) are reported here. Wind gusts and winds at higher elevations will be greater.

A HURRICANE WARNING MEANS THAT HURRICANE CONDITIONS ARE EXPECTED SOMEWHERE WITHIN THE WARNING AREA. A WARNING IS TYPICALLY ISSUED 36 HOURS BEFORE THE ANTICIPATED FIRST OCCURRENCE OF TROPICAL STORM FORCE WINDS...CONDITIONS THAT MAKE OUTSIDE PREPARATIONS DIFFICULT OR DANGEROUS. PREPARATIONS TO PROTECT LIFE AND PROPERTY SHOULD BE COMPLETE.

DISCUSSION AND 48-HOUR OUTLOOK

AT 500 AM HST...1500 UTC...THE CENTER OF HURRICANE MAKANI WAS LOCATED NEAR LATITUDE 20.0 NORTH...LONGITUDE 154.6 WEST. MAKANI IS MOVING TOWARD THE WEST-NORTHWEST NEAR 14 MPH...22 KM/H...AND THIS MOTION IS EXPECTED TO CONTINUE FOR THE NEXT 24 HOURS BEFORE MAKANI TAKES A NORTHERLY TURN.

MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS ARE NEAR 130 MPH...215 KM/H...WITH HIGHER GUSTS. MAKANI IS A CATEGORY FOUR HURRICANE ON THE SAFFIR-SIMPSON SCALE. MAKANI IS EXPECTED TO REMAIN A CATEGORY 3 OR 4 HURRICANE OVER THE NEXT 24 HOURS BEFORE RAPIDLY WEAKENING THEREAFTER.

HURRICANE FORCE WINDS EXTEND OUTWARD UP TO 70 MILES...110 KM...FROM THE CENTER...AND TROPICAL STORM FORCE WINDS EXTEND OUTWARD UP TO 230 MILES...370 KM.

ESTIMATED MINIMUM CENTRAL PRESSURE IS 949 MB...28.02 INCHES.

HAZARDS AFFECTING LAND

WINDS...MAKANI WILL GENERATE A SWATH OF DAMAGING WINDS AS IT CROSSES

HAWAII OVER THE NEXT 24 HOURS. SIGNIFICANT WIND DAMAGE AND WIDESPREAD POWER AND COMMUNICATION OUTAGES ARE LIKELY.

SURF...LARGE BREAKING WAVES WILL IMPACT ALL SHORES OF THE HAWAIIAN ISLANDS OVER THE NEXT 24 HOURS. THE LARGE WAVES WILL CAUSE COASTAL INFRASTRUCTURE DAMAGE ALONG WITH COASTAL OVERWASH AND FLOODING.

SURGE...SIGNIFICANT STORM SURGE OF 2 TO 8 FEET IS EXPECTED TO IMPACT ALL ISLANDS OVER THE NEXT 24 HOURS. SURGE WILL BE MAXIMIZED ALONG EASTERN AND SOUTHERN SHORES.

RAINFALL...MAKANI IS EXPECTED TO CREATE 6 TO 14 INCHES OF RAINFALL AND SIGNIFICANT FLOODING. LOCALIZED HEAVIER AMOUNTS ARE LIKELY.
